# The Argument From Conscience (Moral Values)

# Relational Verification of God

Love cannot be measured, Love is neither matter nor energy. Yet love is accepted as a reality because it is demonstrated in relations.

The same concept is applied in our knowledge of God. He is neither matter nor energy. He can be known, experienced, and verified only by the method of relations.

# Pascal's wager

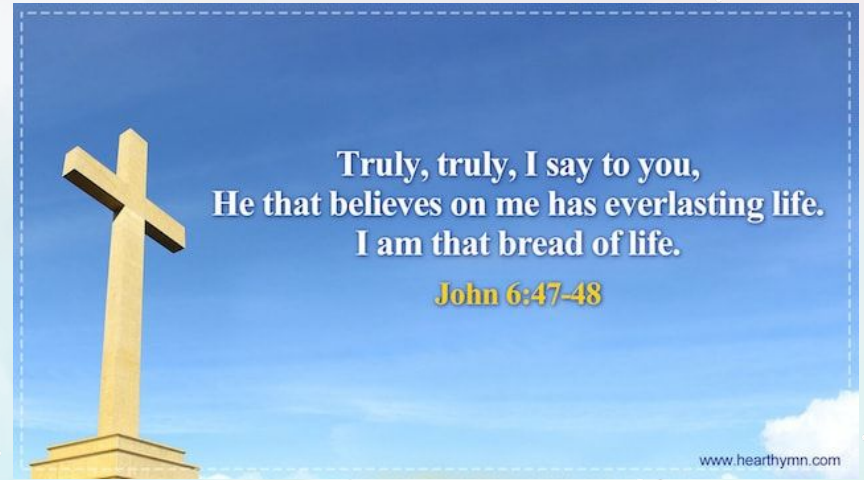
- The wager on God existing for those who believe in it leads to an infinite gain (eternal life) with finite loss, which are the pleasures and sin of the world
- Those that believe that God doesn't exist will have a finite gain, which isn't permanent with an infinite loss
- If there is a wager on God not existing those that believe God exist would hypothetically have a finite loss and those that don't have a finite gain, there is nothing to really lose when believing in God and having faith
- Finite loss is the loss of pleasures of this earth which is sin.

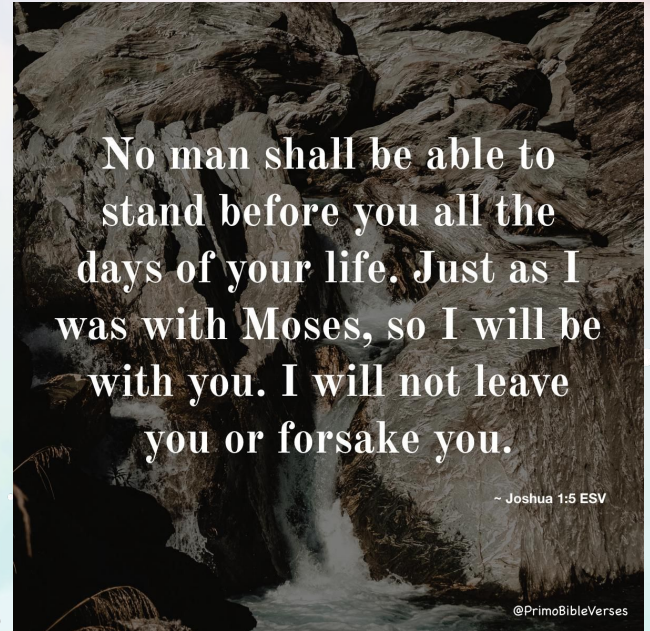
# Considerations

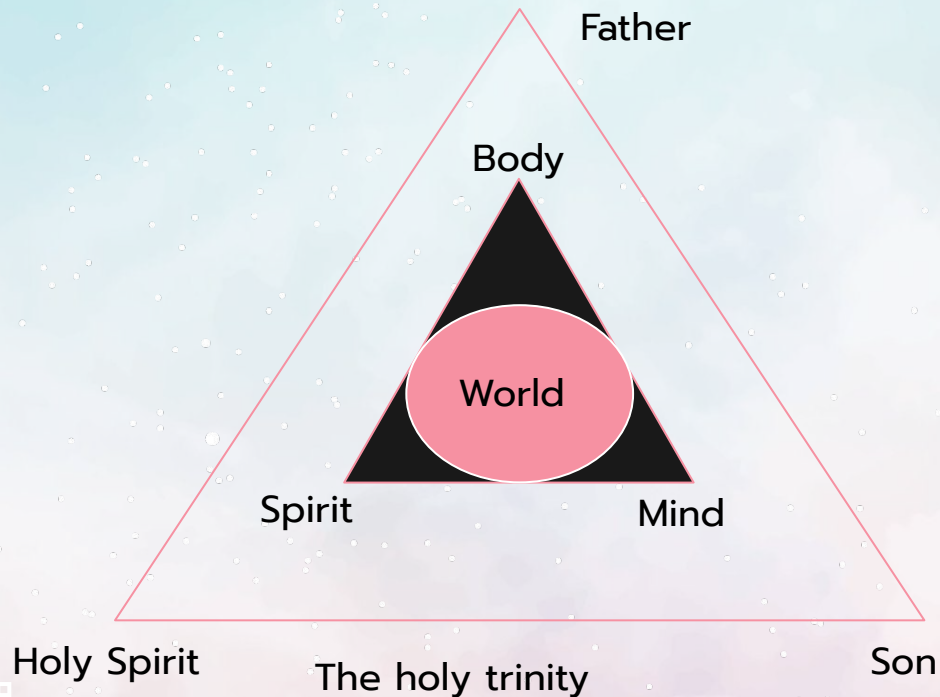
# Salvation

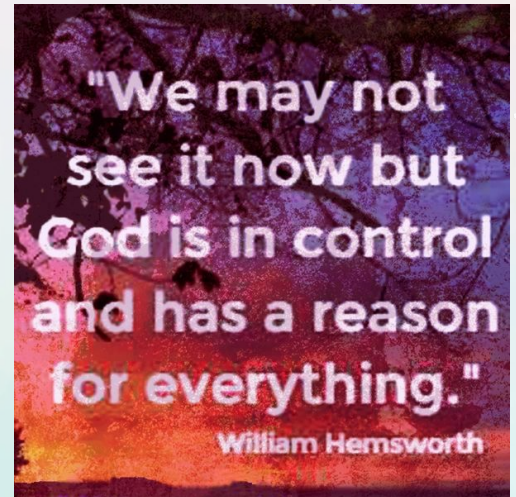
