


Audience: Christians abroad


Applications...Not Philosophy.

1-Humility

For no sooner has the sun risen with a burning heat than it withers the grass; its flower falls, and its beautiful appearance perishes. So the rich man also will fade away in his pursuits."

2- Ask for wisdom from above

James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways."

1 Peter 1:15-16: but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."


Definition of Holy: dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose; sacred.













7 traits under the umbrella of Love.
