What does it really mean to grow spiritually?

To understand how to grow, we need to understand what happened to our nature, and that serves as the foundation of our development.



Spiritual growth Its own image (Gen 1:27).

God created man in His own image (Gen 1:27).

but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die (Genesis 2:17)

Through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men" (Rom 5:12)

Our corrupted human nature is born with Adam's sin (original sin) because we were in Adam when he sinned.

but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die (Genesis 2:17)

- → we now have a nature that is corrupted and evil in its core.
- → we lost our dominion over the creation



→ a new birth is now <u>necessary</u> as a replacement to this defective core

→ In baptism, our lord restored the <u>human</u>
nature to its <u>original</u>
state





when a woman gets pregnant, this new person, his DNA is comprised of the genetic code of the mother and the father.






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Old nature means doing things for your own glory / pride / benefit (worldly reasons).

New nature means doing things for the glory of God, even if this leads me to get out of my comfort zone.

Examples?

- Forgive,
- Serve and spend time for others,
- Don't cheat or lie even if I will loose



What does it really mean to grow spiritually?

- + Our lord wants to know that you are an all time Christian not a part time Saint, and that you will obey his commandments all the time not only when it is convenient for you.
- + Spiritual growth is a life to be lived not a lesson to be learned.

That only happens through a relationship

What does it really mean to grow spiritually?

- •I am not going to liturgy on Sunday because I have to (though I have to), but for me to see God.

- •So the reason why we are not experiencing more of God is because He know that He will not get more glory out of it.


It will only expand your kingdom not His kingdom.
