Don't be in a hurry


- Believe God is working in your life even when you don't feel it.


HOW DO WE GROW?

The Process


- Long and Slow with NO RUSH

OUR COOPERATION


- Holy spirit releases its power the moment you take a step of faith


The 5 R's are useless if we don't implement what we learned The best way to do this with a plan




FOUR STEP PROCESS OF TEMPTATIONS:
