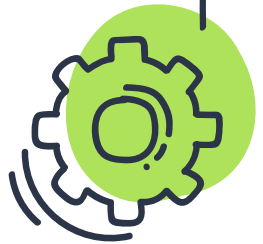

AVAILABLE TO SERVE.

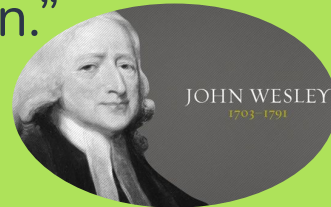
1. Real servants do what's needed, even when it's inconvenient, since interruptions are seen as divine appointments for ministry.

THEIR MINISTRY.

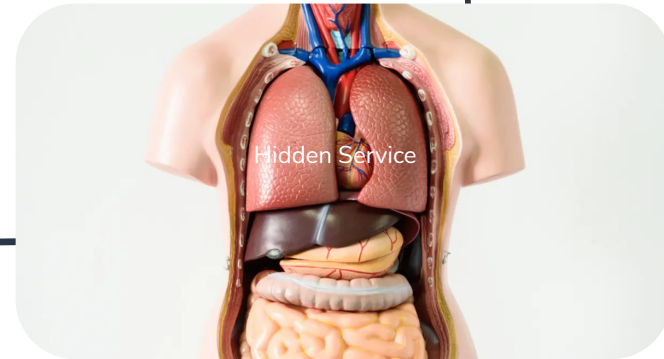
1. They are trustworthy and dependable.

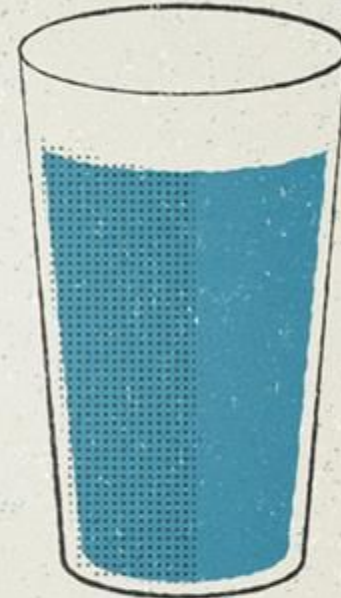
REAL SERVANTS MAINTAIN A






2. SERVANTS THINK LIKE STEWARDS, NOT OWNERS



3. SERVANTS THINK ABOUT THEIR WORK, NOT WHAT OTHERS ARE DOING



4. SERVANTS BASE THEIR IDENTITY IN CHRIST



**“You may brag about yourself, but

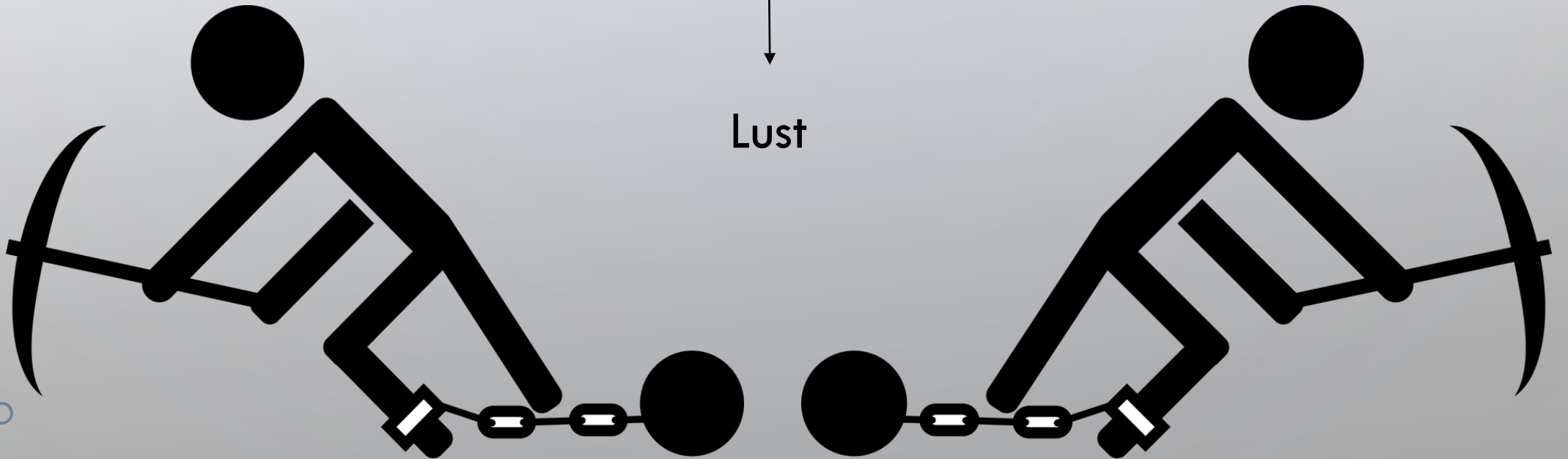

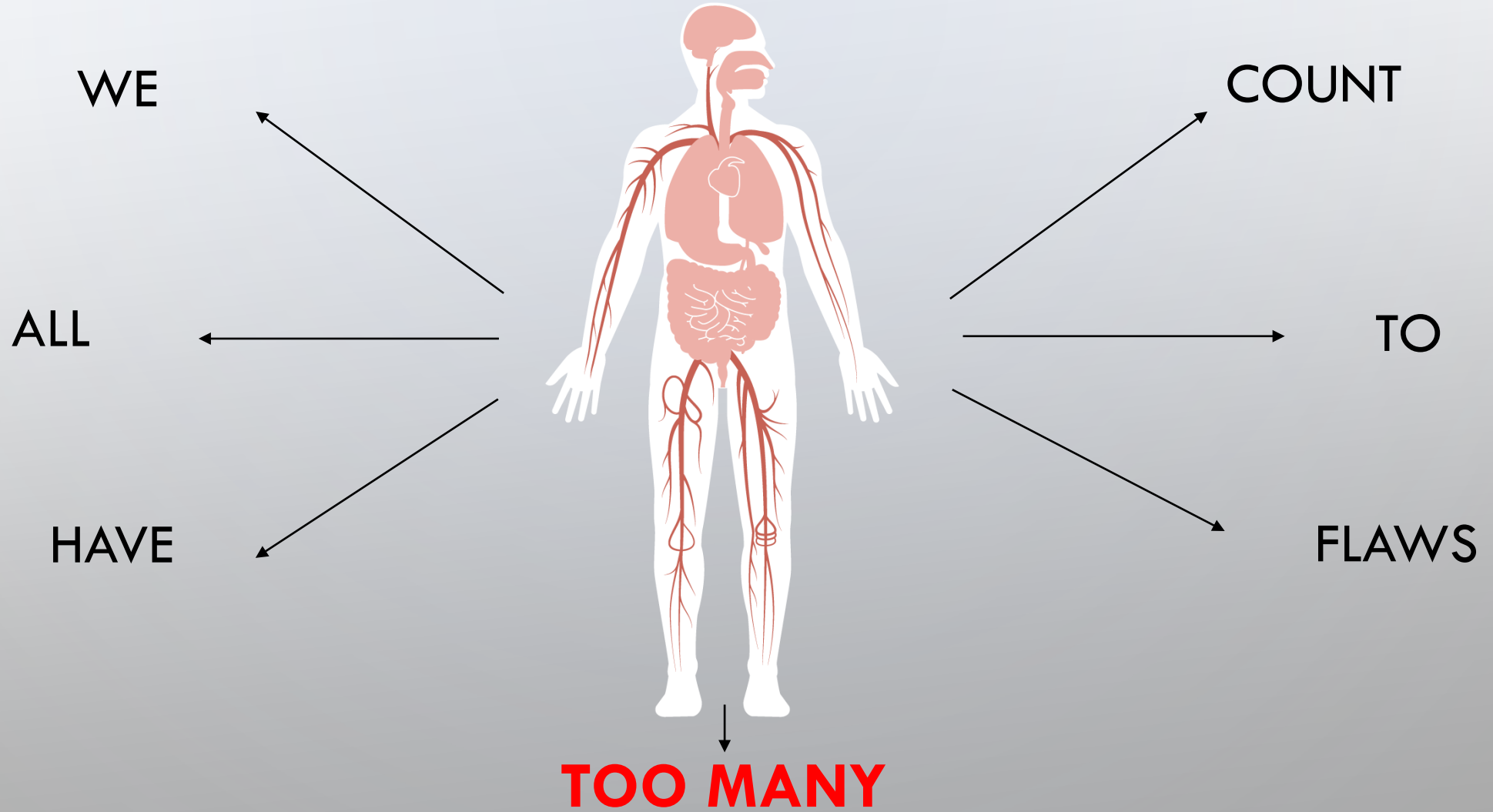
