"Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him."

JAMES 1:12

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- Temptation is just as much an opportunity to do the right thing as it is one to do the wrong thing – it simply provides the choice
- We develop the fruits when we are put in the exact opposite situation

 $\textbf{TEMPTATION} \longrightarrow \textbf{CHOICE}$






- Satan identifies a **desire** inside of you
- Temptation always begins in the mind: it lies within us as well as around us

SATAN'S FOUR-STEP PLAN TO IGNITE TEMPTATION

 $\textbf{TEMPTATION} \longrightarrow \textbf{CHOICE}$




- Satan gets you to **doubt** God's intentions when preventing you from following this temptation
- "Is it really wrong? Didn't God mean this prohibition for someone else? Doesn't God want me to be happy?"



• Satan **deceives** you by convincing you to commit the act

SATAN'S FOUR-STEP PLAN TO IGNITE TEMPTATION

• He tells you that you can get away with it, you can outwit God, everyone else is doing it!



SATAN'S FOUR-STEP PLAN TO IGNITE TEMPTATION

• After the thought has been developing in your head for a while, it is easy to turn it into an action; an act of **disobedience**

OPPORTUNITY TO CHOOSE CHRIST









- Regard a temptation as a compliment; it is not a sign of weakness, it means that Satan is bothered that you are doing something right
- Temptation only becomes a sin when you give into it. It is not a sin to be tempted






REQUEST GOD'S HELP

- Psalm 50:15 "Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me."
 - When temptation strikes, you do not have to initiate a long conversation with God you can just cry for help and He will listen
 - developing a personal relationship with Christ provides an important base for your cry for help

OPPORTUNITY TO CHOOSE CHRIST



- If God is waiting to help us defeat temptation, why don't we turn to Him more often?
 - We want to give in to temptation sometimes
 - We're embarrassed to ask for help

DAY 27 DEFEATING TEMPTATION

"Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart."

2 TIMOTHY 2:22

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- God will never give you more than you can handle, as insurmountable as your temptations may seem
- The book provides four biblical keys to defeating temptation!

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1. **REFOCUS**

YOUR ATTENTION ON SOMETHING ELSE

- The Bible never tells you to resist temptation (you can't!), but to resist the *devil*
 - Psalm 119:37 "Turn away my eyes from looking at worthless things. and revive me in Your way."
- We naturally move towards whatever we focus our attention on
- The principle of replacement: to combat bad thoughts, you must replace them with good thoughts; i.e. the Word of God

1. **REFOCUS** YOUR ATTENTION ON SOMETHING ELS

2. REVEAL

YOUR STRUGGLE TO A SUPPORT GROUP

- Have at least one person to confide in it keeps you grounded and accountable, you should pray for and encourage each other
 - especially if you have been chronically struggling with a temptation
- You should not hide your hurt humble yourself
 - remember that millions of Christians are fighting with you
- What are you pretending isn't a problem in your life? What are you afraid to talk about?

THE DEVIL

- first, accept God's salvation
 - remember that as a child of God, Satan can't force you to do anything, he can only suggest
- second, use the Word of God as your weapon against Satan
 - the devil has hundreds of thousands of years of experience – you can only combat that by internalizing the Word that has been true for even longer

YOUR VULNERABILITY

- any of us can fool ourselves, don't let your guard down
- this mindset keeps you rooted in God, since you realize how little you can do without Him
- remember that it is easier to stay out of temptation than to get out of it

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WHY SPIRITUAL GROWTH TAKES TIME **U2** HOW TO COOPERATE WITH GOD IN SPIRITUAL MATURITY

"Some people grow old but never grow up."

There are no shortcuts to maturity. The development of Christlike character cannot be rushed. Spiritual growth (sanctification), like physical growth, takes time.



"While we worry about how fast we grow, God is concerned about how strong we grow. God views our lives from and for eternity, so He is never in a hurry."

Salvation is the <u>acceptance</u> of the gift of salvation from God by faith and worship, in Christ alone; it is not an immediate total commitment of your life to Christ at first, since at spiritual birth you understand very little about true commitment. The process of true commitment requires the ripening of the fruit of the Holy Spirit in your life, which is time consuming, gradual, and with many steps. It takes *believing* (through worship), belonging (through fellowship) and becoming (through discipleship choices).

Saved humans are slow learners.


• Saved humans have

Spiritual growth is a lifetime commitment and process. A Christian must be patient with themself and with God in the endeavor. In believing, belonging, and becoming to be more Christlike, and the exercise of proper choices in cooperation with the Holy Spirit, the Christian will continually be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ. *Faith and persistence* and *not feelings* are to be the Christian's focus in this preparation of his character, which they will take with them to their eternal home. They must always remember that God is not so much concerned with swiftness, but in strength and stability in the sanctification process.
