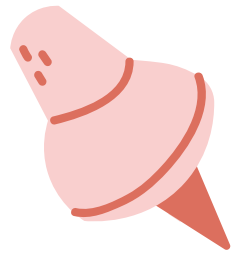

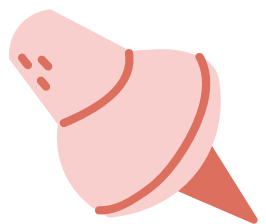

# What Might Be Driving You?

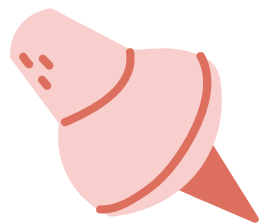
“The fear of man lays a snare, but whoever trusts in the LORD is safe.” Proverbs 29:25

Fear, anger, and stress can take over



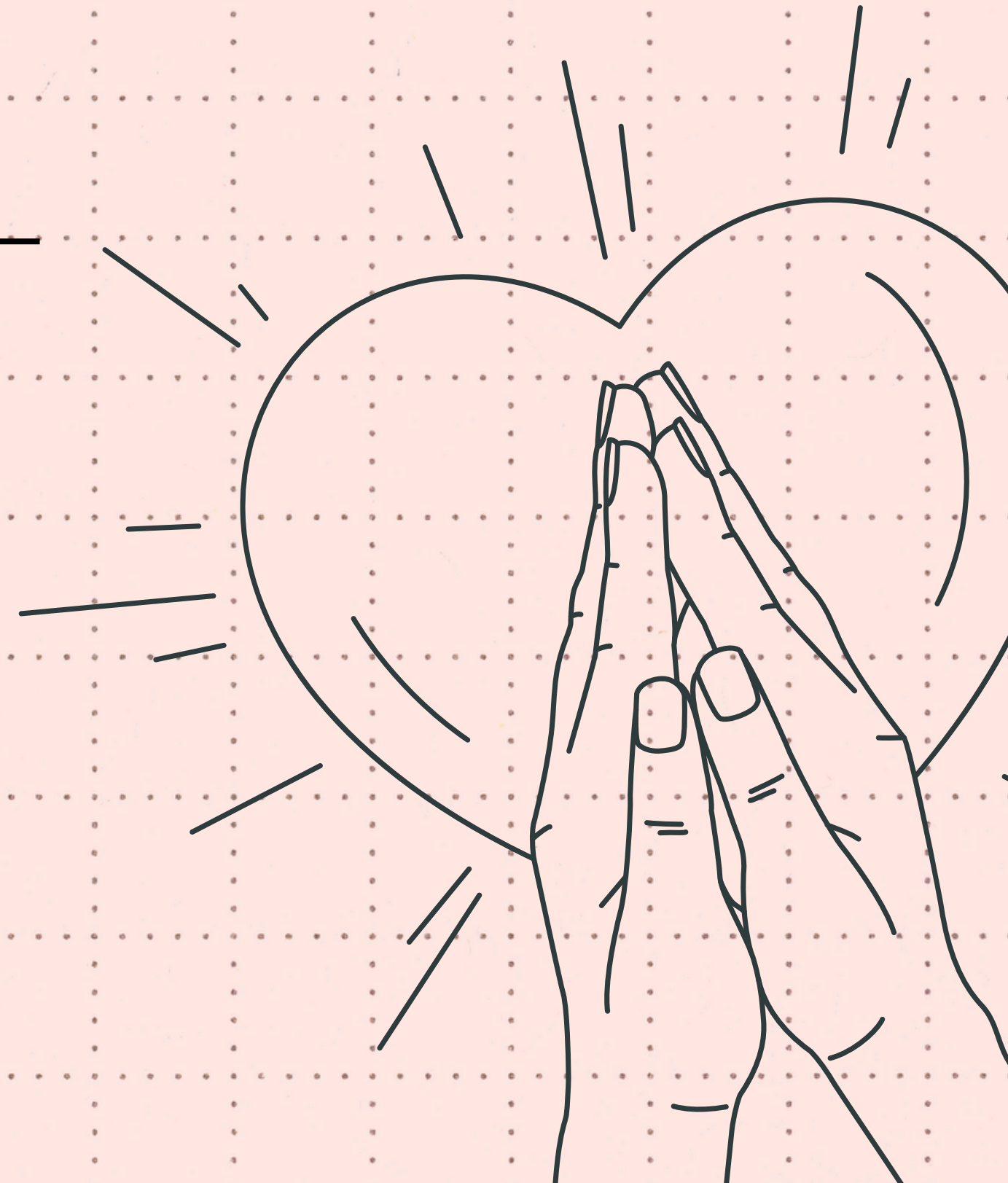
These things create pressure, not peace

# Why Living With Purpose Matters

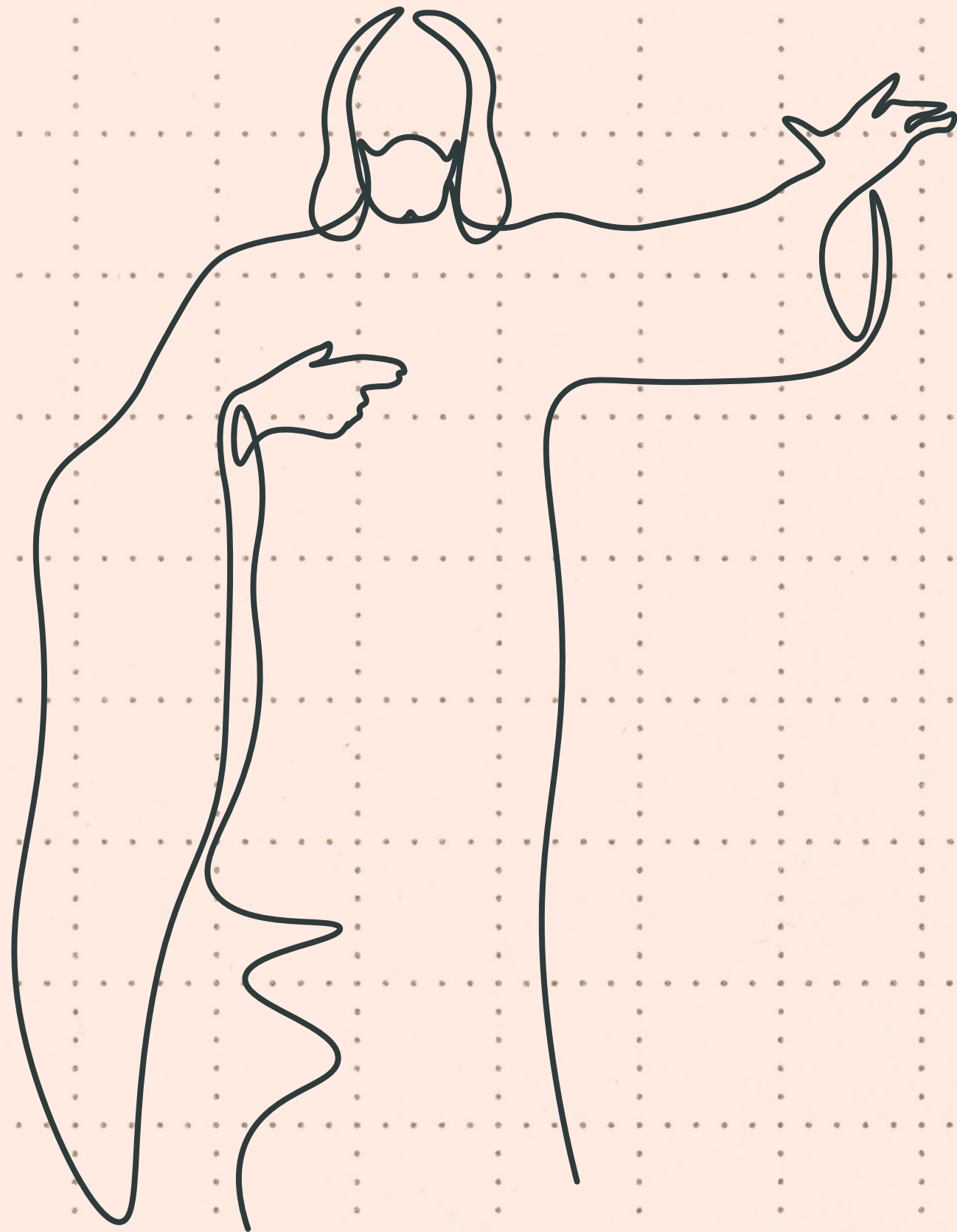

# What Does God Say About It?



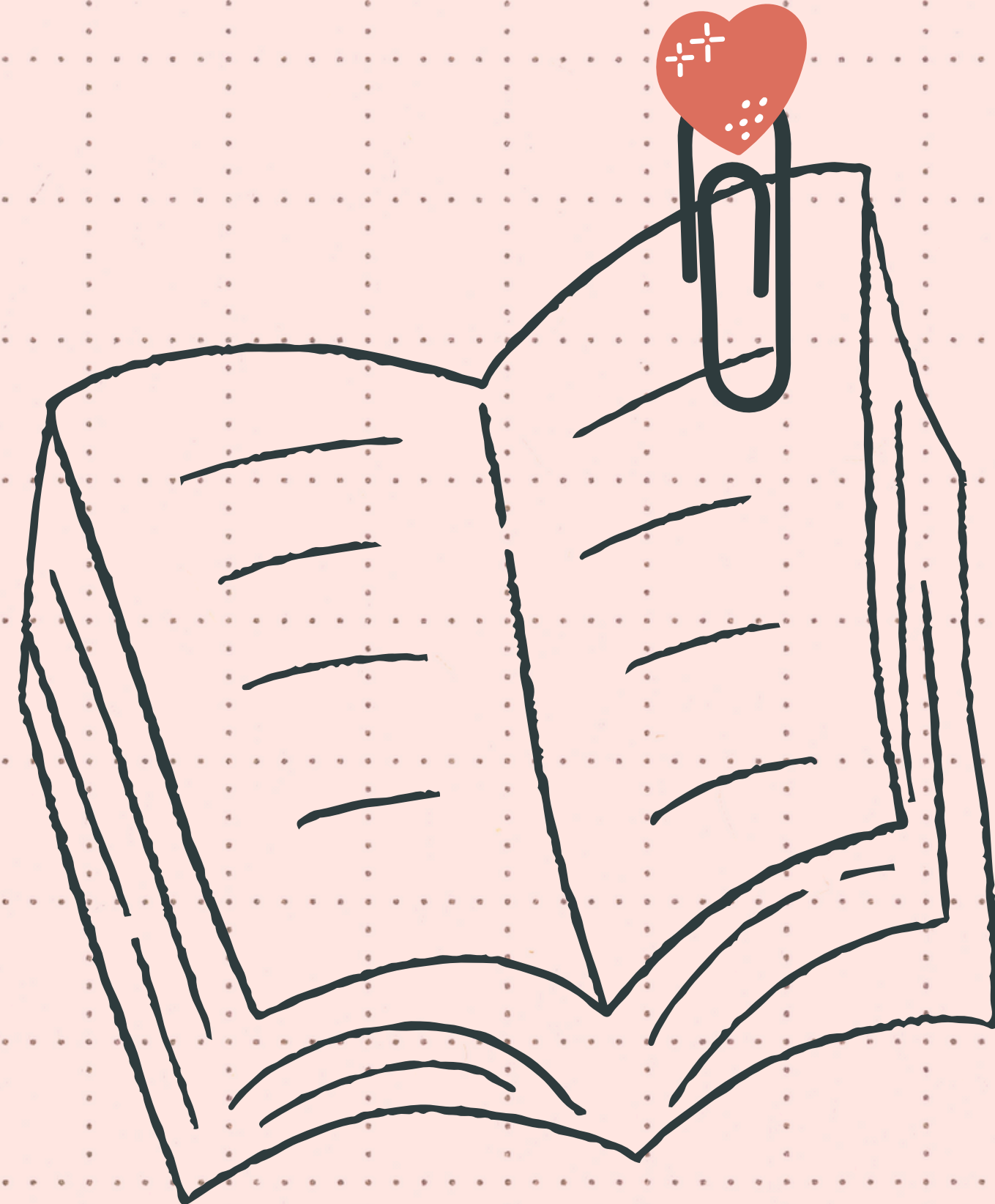
"You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You." Isaiah 26:3

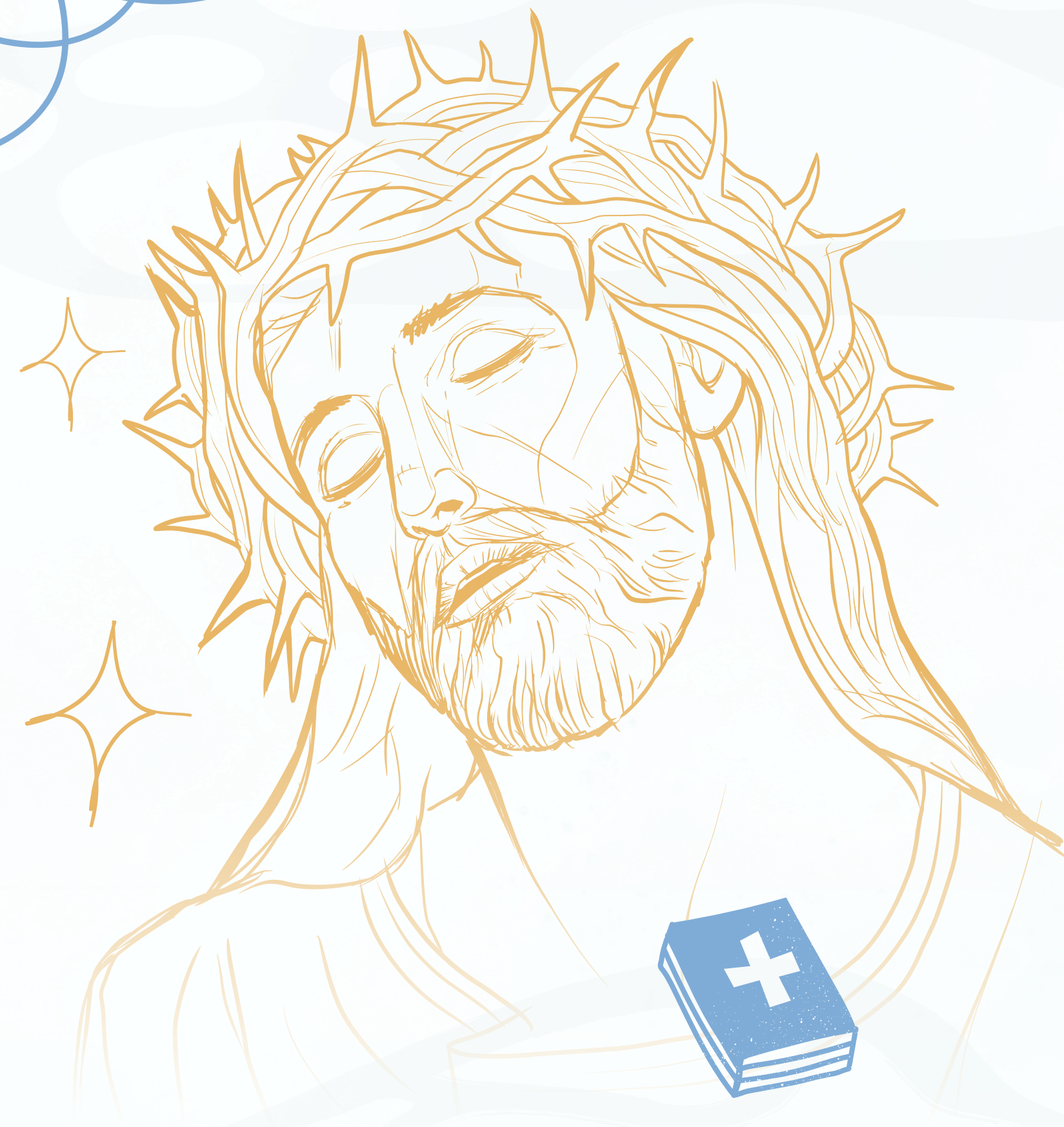

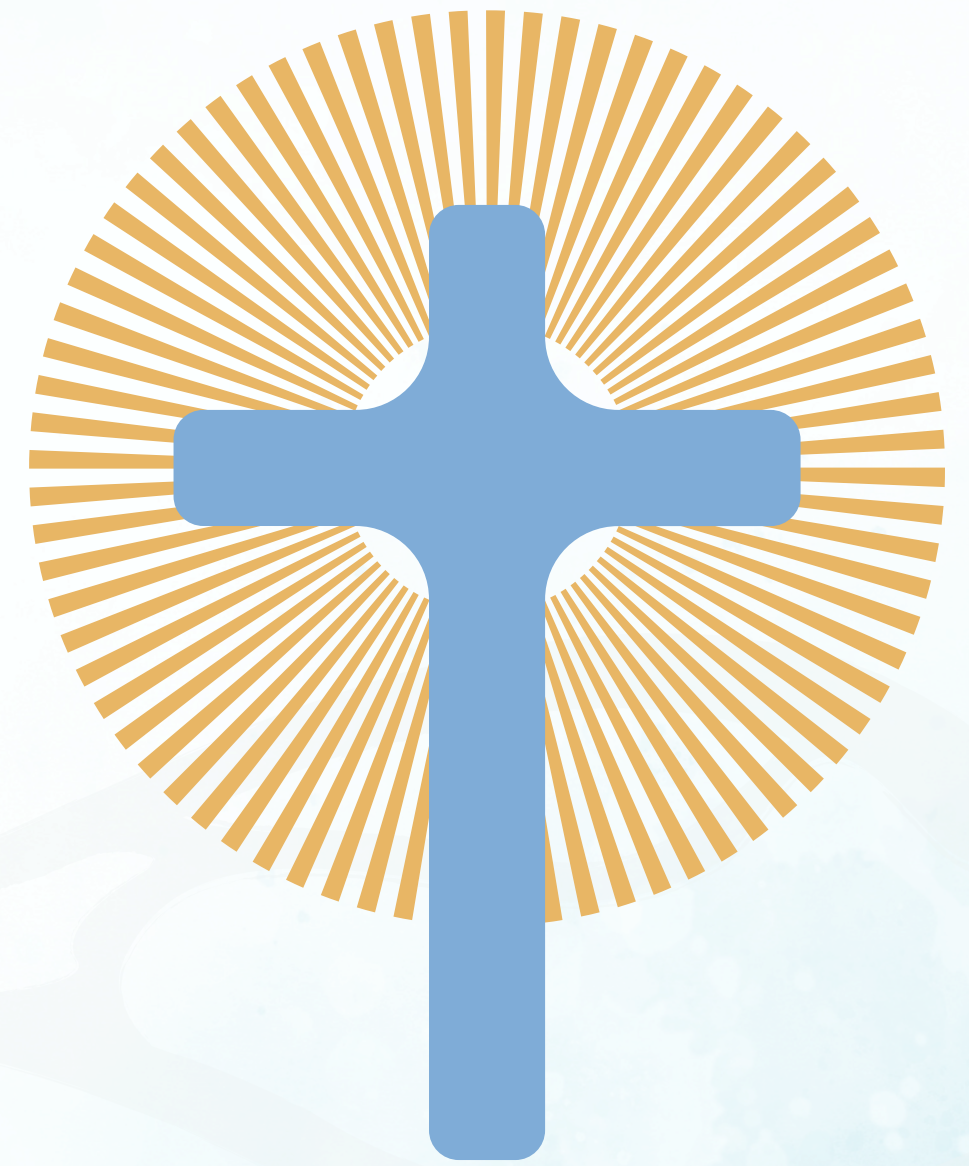


# Made to Last Forever

- Life on earth is like the warm up lap before the real race, eternity
- You have an inborn instinct that longs for immortality
  - This is because God created us in His image, to live for eternity
- Death is not the end of you, its the end of your earthly body but not your spirit







# Eternal Life

While life on earth offers many choices, eternity offers only two: hell or heaven with many mansions



If you learn to love and trust God's Son, Jesus, you will be invited to spend the rest of eternity with him.



On the other hand, if you reject his love, forgiveness, and salvation, you will spend eternity apart from God forever.



# Living with Eternity in Mind



- We need to comprehend that there is more to life than just here and now, and we realize that life is just preparation for eternity, we will begin to live differently.
- Our relationship to God on earth will determine our relationship to Him in eternity.



When we live in light of entirety:

- Problems that seemed important will become small, trivial and unworthy of our attention
- Priorities, values and relationships will change
  - ex. trends, wealth and popularity won't matter as much anymore



# Beyond This Life



"This world is not our home; we are looking forward to our everlasting home in heaven."

- We should not fear death
- If we have a relationship with God through Jesus, we don't need to fear death.
- Death is not our termination, but our transition into eternity

- Our time on earth is just a blink of an eye, but the consequences of it will last forever.
- We should live each day with eternity in mind, treating every day as preparation for our final day



# Conclusion: Applying This Lesson to Our ✧ Spiritual Life and Service

## **Spiritual Life:**

- Life on Earth is temporary, so we should focus on eternal values rather than chasing temporary success.

## **Service:**

- Serving with an eternal perspective means helping others without expecting anything in return.

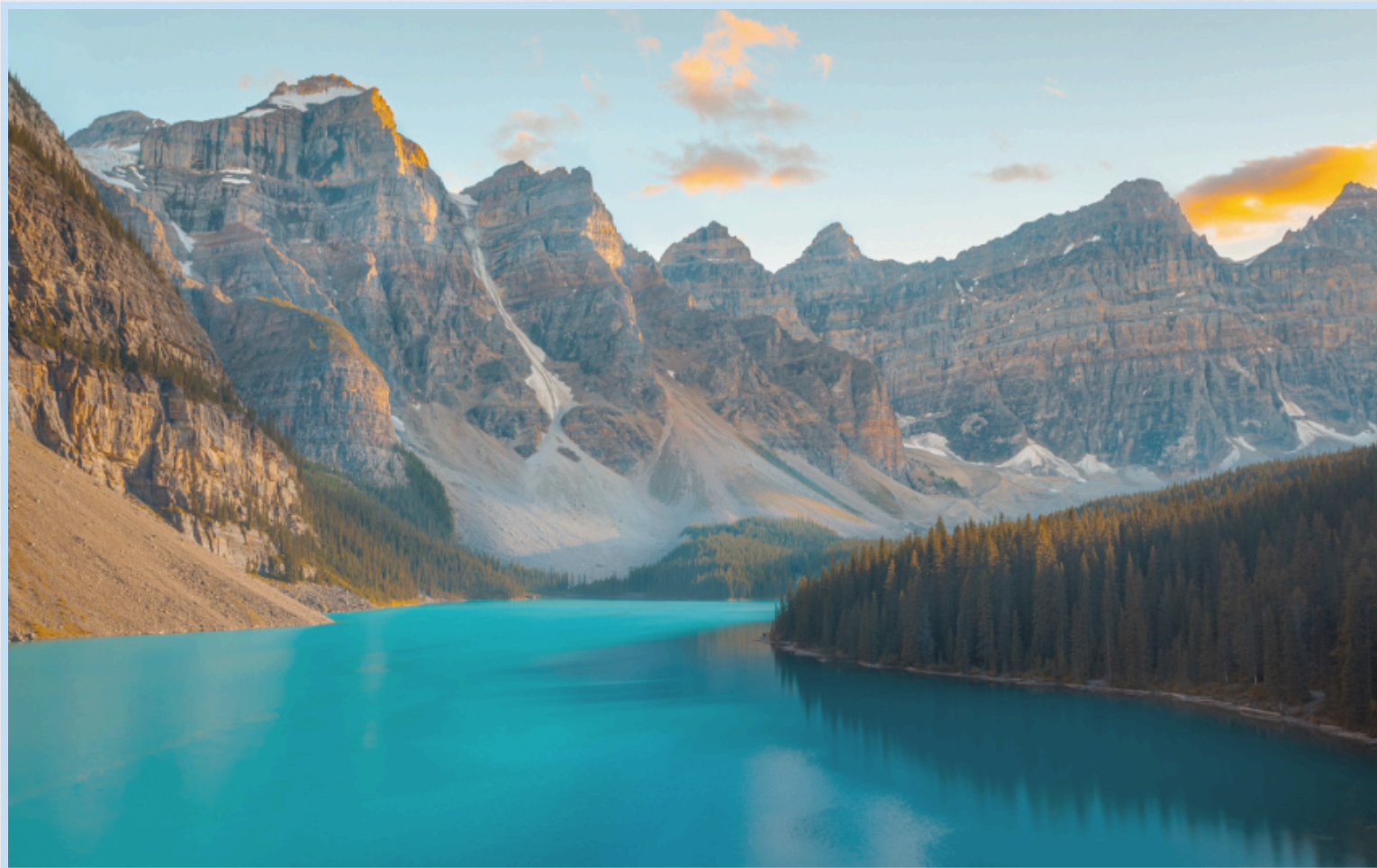

(there shall be no night there)



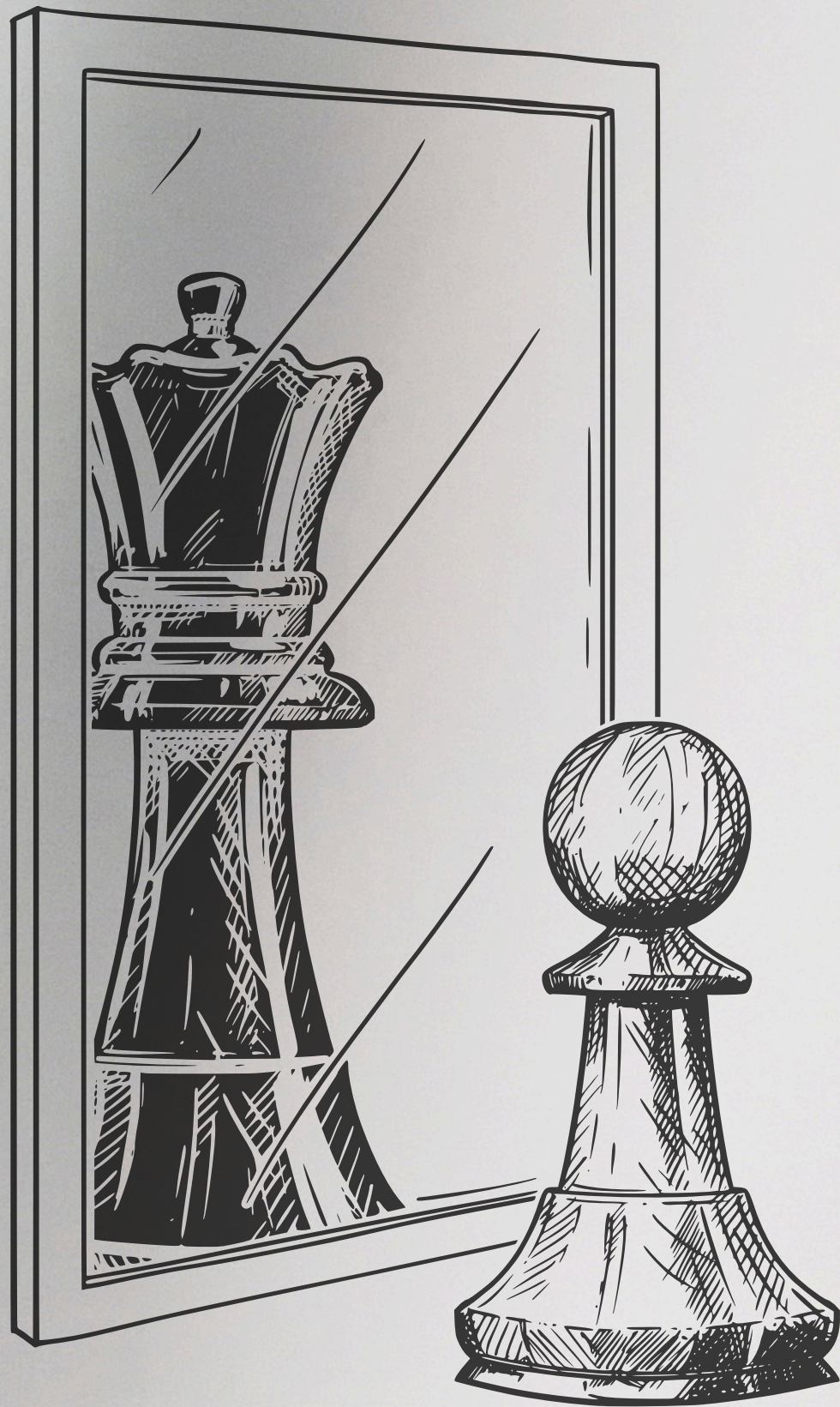


“You cannot see My face; for no man shall see Me, and live.”

- We exist because God loves us and enjoys us.



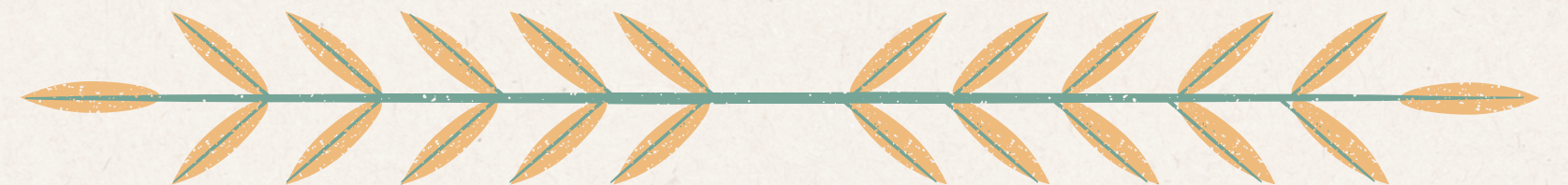
# HOW CAN WE BE MORE CONNECTED TO HIM?
